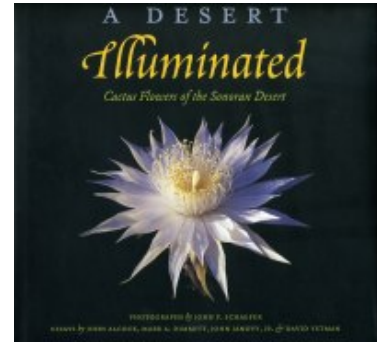


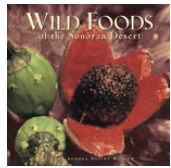

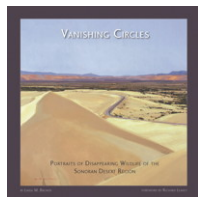

A pocket-sized guide to the desert's underground denizens is must-have reading for curious day hikers, backpackers, and campers.

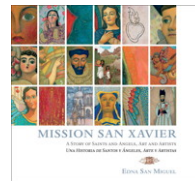
