## Redbud

## Cercis canadensis

**DESCRIPTION:** Texas Redbud (variety *texensis*) and Mexican Redbud (variety Mexicana) are varieties of eastern redbud. They are slightly more compact as well as more drought tolerant. They top out at 15 - 20' tall, and have bright wine red flowers and buds. They bloom in spring on bare branches making for a striking appearance.

**RECOMMENDED USE:** Use as accent or focal point on patio or landscape. Plant in groups or along borders.

## **CULTURE:**

100 m

Hardiness:  $5^{\circ} - 10^{\circ}$ 



Sun tolerance: Light shade to full sun.



Watering and feeding: Moderate and consistent watering.



**Soil requirements**: Does best in fertile well drained soil. Avoid caliche.



Pruning: Remove dead wood as needed.
