## ARIZONA-SONORA DESERT MUSEUM PLANT CARE INFORMATION

### ‘Pink Flamingo’ *Muhlenbergia* ×

**DESCRIPTION:** ‘Pink Flamingo’ is a hybrid between *Muhlenbergia capillaris* and *Muhlenbergia lindheimeri*. This hybrid combines the best of both parents; the pink flowers of the former, and strong vertical form of the latter. It makes a narrow, upright clump of thin blue-green leaves to 4 or 5’ tall. It is topped in the fall with dramatic arching plumes of soft pink flowers.

**RECOMMENDED USE:** It is a good choice for slopes or areas that receive periodic flooding. It makes a great backdrop for lower colorful plants. Use in an enhanced desert landscape or xeriscape. It can also be useful in narrow spaces and in mass plantings.

#### CULTURE:



**Hardiness:** -10°F.



**Sun tolerance:** Autumn Glow® is very adaptable, tolerating full sun to almost full shade



**Watering and feeding:** Low water use once established, but appreciates extra summer irrigation. Feed in the spring.



**Soil requirements:** Tolerant of most soils.



**Pruning:** Can take severe pruning in the early spring to remove brown foliage.
