ARIZONA-SONORA DESERT MUSEUM PLANT CARE INFORMATION

Aztec Pearl *Choisya x dewitteana*

DESCRIPTION: *Choisya* 'Aztec Pearl' makes a 3' to 6' Tall x 2' to 3' wide open shrub with dark, evergreen, finger-like foliage. In mid-spring, the plants are topped with terminal clusters of pale pink buds that open to fragrant, white, citrus-like flowers. Aztec Pearl is a hybrid between the native *Choisya dumosa* and *Choisya ternata*

RECOMMENDED USE: Attractive container plant or foreground sub shrub for patio garden

CULTURE:



Hardiness: upper teens



Sun tolerance: morning sun to light shade



Watering and feeding: moderate water, fertilize in container



Soil requirements: well-drained soil



Pruning: as needed
