PLANT CARE INFORMATION

Tuberous Sida *Rhynchosida physocalyx*

DESCRIPTION: Interesting native perennial, trailing stems emerge from thickened roots in warm temps, flowers are light-peached colored and occur from March – October. Tortoise favorite.

RECOMMENDED USE: Great in native, xeriscape garden, or patio container

CULTURE:



Hardiness: 10°F.



Sun tolerance: Full sun to moderate shade



Watering and feeding: Low water use once established



Soil requirements: Any



Pruning: Prune as needed
