## **Tuberous Sida**

Rhynchosida physocalyx

**DESCRIPTION:** Interesting native perennial, trailing stems emerge from thickened roots in warm temps, flowers are light-peached colored and occur from March – October. Tortoise favorite.

**RECOMMENDED USE:** Great in native, xeriscape garden, or patio container
